

What is meant by Baptism and in which name?

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Repentance is the first step for salvation. Baptism is the second step for salvation. One should confess his sins and take baptism for salvation:

“Baptism” means immerse or dip in the water. “RENTIDZO” means Sprinkling. The people who took baptism in the sacred Scriptures had been immersed in the water. They did not sprinkle when they were babies. Baptism is for the repented people and not for the sinless babies. There is no proof for sprinkling baptism in Scriptures. Sprinkling baptism is a manmade doctrine (Mat 15:9). It has no right to enter into the kingdom of Yahweh. Rebelling against immersion is rejecting the counsel of Yahweh (Luke 7:30). **Shall we go and see very clearly what the scripture sayith about baptism?**

Baptism means to dip/immerse in the water	Sprinkling

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In Which Name We Have To Be Baptized?

Mat 28:19 Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost:

Act 2:38 Then Peter said unto them, Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Yahshua the Messiah for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost.

* Since Father, Son, Holy Ghost are titles but they have one NAME. That is the name of Yahshua the Messiah. So all the baptizers baptized in the name of Yahshua the Messiah only.

Act 4:12 Neither is there salvation in any other: for there is none other name under heaven given among men, whereby we must be saved.

<p>Who were Baptized and Who had given? Through John The Baptist:</p> <p>Mat 3:5 Then went out to him Jerusalem, and all Judaea, and all the region round about Jordan,</p> <p>Mat 3:6 And were baptized of him in Jordan, confessing their sins. Through The Disciples of Yahshua Messiah

Joh 4:1 When therefore Yahweh knew how the Pharisees had heard that Yahshua made and baptized more disciples than John,
Joh 4:2 (Though Yahshua himself baptized not, but his disciples,)

Through Peter (Kefa)

Act 2:38 Then Peter said unto them, Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Yahshua Messiah for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost.

Act 2:39 For the promise is unto you, and to your children, and to all that are afar off, *even* as many as Yahweh our Elohim shall call.

Act 2:40 And with many other words did he testify and exhort, saying, Save yourselves from this untoward generation.

Act 2:41 Then they that gladly received his word were baptized: and the same day there were added *unto them* about three thousand souls. **[3000 were added to main assembly]**

Through Philip the Evangelist

Act 8:12 But when they believed Philip preaching the things concerning the kingdom of Elohim, and the name of Yahshua Messiah, they were baptized, **[both men and women.]**

Act 8:13 Then Simon himself believed also: and when he was baptized, he continued with Philip, and wondered, beholding the miracles and signs which were done.

[Simon the sorcerer was also baptized]

Act 8:37 And Philip said, If thou believest with all thine heart, thou mayest. And he answered and said, I believe that Yahshua Messiah is the Son of Elohim.

Act 8:38 And he commanded the chariot to stand still: and they went down both into the water, both Philip and the eunuch; and he baptized him. **[Eunuch was baptized]**

Through Peter (Kefa) and John:

Act 8:14 Now when the apostles which were at Jerusalem heard that Samaria had received the word of Elohim, they sent unto them Peter and John: **[Samaritans were baptized]**

Act 8:15 Who, when they were come down, prayed for them, that they might receive the Holy Ghost:

Act 8:16 (For as yet he was fallen upon none of them: only they were baptized in the name of the Sovereign Yahshua Messiah.)

Through Peter (Kefa)

Act 10:47 Can any man forbid water, that these should not be baptized, which have received the Holy Ghost as well as we?

Act 10:48 And he commanded them to be baptized in the name of Yahshua the Messiah. Then prayed they him to tarry certain days. **[Household of Cornelius were baptized]**

No apostle in the first century given baptism in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit nor given baptism in the name of Jesus Christ.

Through Paul/Saul

Act 16:15 And when she was baptized, and her household, she besought *us*, saying, If ye have judged me to be faithful to Yahweh, come into my house, and abide *there*. And she con

Act 16:30 And brought them out, and said, Sirs, what must I do to be saved? **[Lydia was baptized]**

Act 16:31 And they said, Believe on the Sovereign Yahshua Messiah and thou shalt be saved, and thy house.

Act 16:32 And they spake unto him the word of the Sovereign, and to all that were in his house.

Act 16:33 And he took them the same hour of the night, and washed *their* stripes; and was baptized, he and all his, straight-way. **[The Prisoner and his house hold were baptized]**

Act 18:8 And Crispus, the chief ruler of the synagogue, believed on the Sovereign with all his house; and many of the Corinthians hearing believed, and were baptized.

[Many Corinthians were baptized]

Act 18:25 This man was instructed in the way of the Sovereign; and being fervent in the spirit, he spake and taught diligently the things of the Sovereign, knowing only the baptism of John.

Act 18:26 And he began to speak boldly in the synagogue: whom when Aquila and Priscilla had heard, they took him unto *them*, and expounded unto him the way of Elohim more perfectly. **[Apollow was baptized]**

Act 19:5 When they heard *this*, they were baptized in the name of the Sovereign Yahshua. [John's disciples were baptized]

Rom 6:3 Know ye not, that so many of us as were baptized into Yahshua Messiah were baptized into his death?

Rom 6:4 Therefore we are buried with him by baptism into death: **[Romans were baptized]**

Col 2:12 Buried with him in baptism, wherein also ye are risen with *him* through the faith of the operation of God, who hath raised him from the dead.[Colossians were baptized]

1Co 1:14 I thank Elohim that I baptized none of you, but Crispus and Gaius; **[Crispus and Gaius were baptized]**

1Co 1:16 And I baptized also the household of Stephanas: besides, I know not whether I baptized any other.

[Stephanas house hold were baptized]

Gal 3:27 For as many of you as have been baptized into Mes

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siah have put on Messiah. [Galatians were baptized]
Act 16:14 And a certain woman named Lydia, a seller of purple, of the city of Thyatira, which worshipped Elohim, heard *us*: whose heart Yahweh opened, that she attended unto the things which were spoken of Paul.

Through Ananias

Act 22:16 And now why tarriest thou? arise, and be baptized, and wash away thy sins, calling on the name of Yahweh.

Act 9:18 And immediately there fell from his eyes as it had been scales: and he received sight forthwith, and arose, and was baptized. [Saul was baptized]

According to all these records every one in the first century was baptized in the NAME of Yahshua the Messiah only.

No apostle in the first century given baptism in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit nor given baptism in the name of Jesus Christ.
