1. More subtle mindedness:

Gen 3:1 Now the serpent was more subtil than any beast of the field which YHWH Elohim had made.

2. Doubting on YHWH's words: (Beguiling)

Gen 3:1 And he said unto the woman, Yea, hath Elohim said, Ye shall not eat of every tree of the garden?

3. Preaches to believe in LIE:

Gen 3:4 And the serpent said unto the woman, Ye shall not surely die:

Gen 3:5 For Elohim doth know that in the day ye eat thereof, then your eyes shall be opened, and ye shall be as gods, knowing good and evil

4. Entices with LIES:

Gen 3:6 And when the woman saw that the tree *was* good for food, and that it *was* pleasant to the eyes, and a tree to be desired to make *one* wise, she took of the fruit thereof, and did eat, and gave also unto her husband with her; and he did eat.

5. Spoils others too:

Gen 3:7 And the eyes of them both were opened, and they knew that they were naked; and they sewed fig leaves together, and made themselves aprons.

6. Teaches to hide:

Gen 3:8 And they heard the voice of YHWH Elohim walking in the garden in the cool of the day: and Adam and his wife hid themselves from the presence of YHWH Elohim amongst the trees of the garden.

7. Teaches to break:

Gen 3:9 And YHWH Elohim called unto Adam, and said unto him, Where art thou?

Gen 3:10 And he said, I heard thy voice in the garden, and I was afraid, because I was naked; and I hid myself.

Gen 3:11 And he said, Who told thee that thou *wast* naked? Hast thou eaten of the tree, whereof I commanded thee that thou shouldest not eat?

8. Blames others never confesses it's fault

Gen 3:12 And the man said, The woman whom thou gavest *to be* with me, she gave me of the tree, and I did eat.

Gen 3:13 And YHWH Elohim said unto the woman, What *is* this *that* thou hast done? And the woman said, The serpent beguiled me, and I did eat.

9. Shows wrath and no beauty in face:

Gen 4:5 But unto Cain and to his offering he had not respect. And Cain was very wroth, and his countenance fell.

10. Does evil works:

Gen 4:5 But unto Cain and to his offering he had not respect. And Cain was very wroth, and his countenance fell.

Gen 4:6 And YHWH said unto Cain, Why art thou wroth? and why is thy countenance fallen?

Gen 4:7 If thou doest well, shalt thou not be accepted? and if thou doest not well, sin lieth at the door. And unto thee *shall be* his desire, and thou shalt rule over him.

11. Rose up aginst and murders:

Gen 4:8 And Cain talked with Abel his brother: and it came to pass, when they were in the field, that Cain rose up against Abel his brother, and slew him.

12. perverting responces:

Gen 4:9 And YHWH said unto Cain, Where *is* Abel thy brother? And he said, I know not: *Am* I my brother's keeper?

Gen 4:10 And he said, What hast thou done? the voice of thy brother's blood crieth unto me from the ground.

13. Cursed, job cursed, everything cursed and vagabondism:

Gen 4:11 And now *art* thou cursed from the earth, which hath opened her mouth to receive thy brother's blood from thy hand;

Gen 4:12 When thou tillest the ground, it shall not henceforth yield unto thee her strength; a fugitive and a vagabond shalt thou be in the earth.

(Cursed wife, cursed food , cursed children and everything is cursed.)

14. Fellowships with worldly people:

Gen 6:2 That the sons of Elohim saw the daughters of men that they were fair; and they took them wives of all which they chose.

15. Addicted to bad habits: (Righteous people will also be spoiled)

Gen 9:21 And he drank of the wine, and was drunken; and he was uncovered within his tent.

16. Inspires to commit adultery

Gen 19:5 And they called unto Lot, and said unto him, Where *are* the men which came in to thee this night? bring them out unto us, that we may know them.

17. Begins to do outrageous things:

Gen 19:9 And they said, Stand back. And they said *again*, This one *fellow* came in to sojourn, and he will needs be a judge: now will we deal worse with thee, than with them. And they pressed sore upon the man, *even* Lot, and came near to break the door.

Gen 19:10 But the men put forth their hand, and pulled Lot into the house to them, and shut to the door

18. Mocks

Gen 19:14 And Lot went out, and spake unto his sons in law, which married his daughters, and said, Up, get you out of this place; for YHWH will destroy this city. But he seemed as one that mocked unto his sons in law.

19. Procrastinates : (Lingers)

Gen 19:15 And when the morning arose, then the angels hastened Lot, saying, Arise, take thy wife, and thy two daughters, which are here; lest thou be consumed in the iniquity of the city.

Gen 19:16 And while he lingered, the men laid hold upon his hand, and upon the hand of his wife, and upon the hand of his two daughters; YHWH being merciful unto him: and they brought him forth, and set him without the city.

20. Inspires to fornication:

Gen 19:31 And the firstborn said unto the younger, Our father *is* old, and *there is* not a man in the earth to come in unto us after the manner of all the earth:

Gen 19:32 Come, let us make our father drink wine, and we will lie with him, that we may preserve seed of our father.

21. Pours fear towards men:

Gen 26:7 And the men of the place asked *him* of his wife; and he said, She *is* my sister: for he feared to say, *She is* my wife; lest, *said he*, the men of the place should kill me for Rebekah; because she *was* fair to look upon.

22. Shows Jealousy: (Envied)

Gen 26:14 For he had possession of flocks, and possession of herds, and great store of servants: and the Philistines envied him.

23. Brings grief of mind:

Gen 26:35 Which were a grief of mind unto Isaac and to Rebekah.

24. Purposing to kill because of hatrate:

Gen 27:41 And Esau hated Jacob because of the blessing wherewith his father blessed him: and Esau said in his heart, The days of mourning for my father are at hand; then will I slay my brother Jacob.

Gen 27:42 And these words of Esau her elder son were told to Rebekah: and she sent and called Jacob her younger son, and said unto him, Behold, thy brother Esau, as touching thee, doth comfort himself, *purposing* to kill thee.

25. Brings weary of life:

Gen 27:46 And Rebekah said to Isaac, I am weary of my life because of the daughters of Heth: if Jacob take a wife of the daughters of Heth, such as these *which are* of the daughters of the land, what good shall my life do me?
