

Who Teaches With Criticism?

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(As instructed in 1 Peter 3:15,16 and Proverbs 26:5, this is our answer to the followers of Satan who spreads false rumours that we are preaching with criticism).

The name Jesus Christ is wrong, Yahshua Messiah is the right name;

Worship on Sunday is wrong, Saturday is the correct day of rest.

Calling it the 'Lord's Supper' participating in it on whatever day and even during the daytime is wrong; It should be celebrated only once a year (Nisan 14) and this should be on the day before the Messiah was crucified which was in the evening.

Since we are pointing out the false doctrines with criticisms, people are coming out of their churches and are joining us in accepting the truth.

Teaching means to criticise (1 Corinthians 14:24). Yahweh, our Heavenly Father is a great critic/judge. He is the one who judges and teaches. His servants, too, will criticise and teach. The truth is revealed by criticism. Therefore, criticism is very necessary for teaching.

YAHWEH IS THE CRITIC/JUDGE

- 1) **Isaiah 3:13,14** — Yahweh stands up to plead, and stands to **judge** the people. Yahweh will enter into **judgement** with the elders of His people and His princes.
- 2) **Ecclesiastes 12:14** — For Elohim will bring every work into **judgement**, including every secret thing, whether it is good or whether it is evil.
- 3) **Revelations 19:11** — ... and in righteousness He **judges** and makes war.
- 4) **1 Corinthians 4:4** — He who **judges** me is Yahweh.
- 5) **Jeremiah 6:15** — “Were they ashamed when they had committed abomination? No! They were not at all ashamed; nor did they know how to blush. Therefore they shall fall among those who fall; at the time I **punish** them, they shall be cast down,” says Yahweh.
- 6) **Matthew 11:22,24** — In the day of **judgement** ...

YAHWEH'S SERVANTS ARE CRITICS/JUDGES

- 1) **Deuteronomy 21:5** — By their (Levi priests) word every controversy and every assault shall be settled.
- 2) **Ezekiel 44:24** — In controversy they shall stand as judges, and judge it according to my judgments.
- 3) **1 Corinthians 14:24** — But if all prophecy, and an unbeliever or an uninformed person comes in, he is convinced by all, he is judged by all.
- 4) **1 Corinthians 6:1-5** — ... Do you not know that the saints will judge the world? ...

□ Let us consider John's teachings. (Wasn't John's teaching filled with criticism?)

— For John had said to him (Herod), “It is not lawful for you to have her (his brother's wife).” Matthew 14:4.

— For Herod himself had sent and laid hold of John, and bound him in prison for the sake of Herodias, his brother Philip's wife: for he had married her. For John had said to Herod, “It is not lawful for you to have your brother's wife. Mark 6:17,18.

— But Herod the tetrarch, being rebuked by him concerning Herodias, his brother Philip's wife, and for all the evils which Herod had done. Luke 3:19.

□ **Let us consider Nathan's teachings. (Wasn't Nathan's teaching filled with criticism?)**

— Read about how Prophet Nathan rebuked David about Uriah's wife in 2 Samuel 15 (**Wasn't Nathan's teaching filled with criticism?**).

All teachers of the Bible taught with criticism. Anyone who errs will not be able to stand against the teachings filled with criticism. Neither are they able to bear teachings filled with criticism. That is why they turn aside. Satan and his followers will not stand for truth. They go astray.

The Heavenly Father hates people who desire another man's wife (Jeremiah 5:8), who commit adultery with their neighbour's wife (Jeremiah 29:22) and who have illegal relationships with women who attend church (I Samuel 2:22).

He answered, "Anyone who divorces his wife and marries another woman commits adultery against her and if she divorces her husband and marries another man she commits adultery." Mark 10:11, 12. (**Aren't these words of Messiah judgemental?**) "I hate divorce says Elohim Yahweh of Israel and I hate a man covering himself with violence as well as with his garments says the Elohim almighty." (Malachi 2:16, read 14 and 15 verses also). **Are these statements not judgemental?**

Adulterous people cannot be Yahweh's servants or evangelists. Whoever commits adultery are not His servants. Anyone who has two or three wives is considered to be adulterous according to the scriptures. So, they are not worthy of being servants of Elohim and also they should not be given any kind of authority or permitted on the pulpit to preach in the society. The priest who has the knowledge of Scriptures will not ordain such persons to ministry and preaching. A priest should only allow this type of person to come into the assembly and go. So, how can such persons of questionable character be shepherds of assemblies? The Scriptures teaches that whoever is aspiring for power and authority or anticipating leadership should be husband of only one wife.

How can adulterers (1 Timothy 3:2) be ordained for ministry? Whose servants will they be? Will Yahweh accept them? Did Yahweh call them? Yahweh, who told the kings, priests and Levites to be pure without committing adultery, will not accept adulterous people. (Deuteronomy 17:17; Leviticus 21:7,13; Proverbs 31:3). With which adulterer in the Bible are you likening yourself to and doing your ministry? There are some false preachers who clamour for ministry without Yahweh's calling. Believers, ask your preachers, how many wives he has, then forsake him, accept and follow the truth. Preachers who are adulterers are not worthy to enter into the kingdom of Heaven. People desire and love the sins of the world rather than goodness. Look for whom they are desire? Do they have the power to face and withstand the day of judgement and punishment?

People like false teachings and false preachers rather than truth and righteous preachers. They believe false doctrines and false truth (Jeremiah 5:30,31).

They demand for the bad:

We only want Barabbas (Matthew 27:20);

We only want Sheba (2 Samuel 20:1-2);

We only want traditions (Matthew 15:6);
We only want drunkard preachers (Micah 2:11);
We only want our blood relations (Judges 9:1-4);
We want our own king (1 Samuel 8:19-20);
We want Absalom (2 Samuel 15:10);
We want organisation (1 Kings 22:6);
We want a goddess (A golden calf) (Exodus 32:1);
We want false gods' priests only (Deuteronomy 11:14-15, 13:9);
We want our own preachers who are convenient for us (2 Timothy 3:4).

But all these false preachers and deceivers of people are condemned to eternal hell fire, not to heaven.

Now no chastening seems to be joyful for the present, but grievous (Hebrews 12:11). Read the following references also: Amos 5:10; Micah 7:4; Hosea 14:9; 2 Timothy 4:3; Proverbs 9:7.

“Therefore they shall fall among those who fall; at the time I punish (Criticise) them, they shall be cast down” says Yahweh (Jeremiah 6:15).
