

# When will You hear His voice?

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If you hear His voice in a right time and in a right way you will be blessed. But if you do not hear His voice in a right time you have to hear Him at these occasions. Would you like to invite such occasions in your life? Look at these references when they hear His voice.

## 1. At the time of Fear Troubles and Destruction:

Pro 1:27 When your fear cometh as desolation, and your destruction cometh as a whirlwind; when distress and anguish cometh upon you.

Pro 1:28 Then shall they call upon me, but I will not answer; they shall seek me early, but they shall not find me:

## 2. In Troubles: at the time of hungar and thirsty:

Psa 107:4 They wandered in the wilderness in a solitary way; they found no city to dwell in.

Psa 107:5 Hungry and thirsty, their soul fainted in them.

Psa 107:6 Then they cried unto the Yahweh in their trouble, and he delivered them out of their distresses.

## 3. In helpless condition and in distress:

Psa 107:12 Therefore he brought down their heart with labour; they fell down, and there was none to help.

Psa 107:13 Then they cried unto the Yahweh in their trouble, and he saved them out of their distresses.

## 4. In the time of darkness and at the shadow of death:

Psa 107:14 He brought them out of darkness and the shadow of death, and brake their bands in sunder.

Psa 107:19 Then they cry unto the Yahweh in their trouble, and he saveth them out of their distresses.

## 5 In Troubles:

Psa 107:28 Then they cry unto the Yahweh in their trouble, and he bringeth them out of their distresses.

## 6. At the time of bedridden:

2.Ch 32:24 In those days Hezekiah was sick to the death, and prayed unto the Yahweh: and he spake unto him, and he gave him a sign.

## 7. At the time of affliction and punishment:

2Ch 33:11 Wherefore the Yahweh brought upon them the captains of the host of the king of Assyria, which took Manasseh among the thorns, and bound him with fetters, and carried him to Babylon.

2.Ch 33:12 And when he was in affliction, he besought the Yahweh his Elohim, and humbled himself greatly before the Elohim of his fathers,

2Ch 33:13 And prayed unto him: and he was intreated of him, and heard his supplication, and brought him again to Jerusalem into his kingdom. Then Manasseh knew that the Yahweh he was Elohim.

## 8. In oppression:

Jud 4:3 And the children of Israel cried unto the Yahweh: for he had nine hundred chariots of iron; and twenty years he mightily oppressed the children of Israel.

## 9. In Impoverishment:

Jud 6:6 And Israel was greatly impoverished because of the Midianites; and the children of Israel cried unto the Yahweh.

#### **10. When enemies troubling:**

Jud 6:7 And it came to pass, when the children of Israel cried unto the Yahweh because of the Midianites,

#### **11. When enemies raged:**

Jud 10:8 And that year they vexed and oppressed the children of Israel: eighteen years, all the children of Israel that were on the other side Jordan in the land of the Amorites, which is in Gilead.

Jud 10:9 Moreover the children of Ammon passed over Jordan to fight also against Judah, and against Benjamin, and against the house of Ephraim; so that Israel was sore distressed.

Jud 10:10 And the children of Israel cried unto the Yahweh, saying, We have sinned against thee, both because we have forsaken our Elohim, and also served Baalim.

#### **12. When everything is coming to end:**

Jud 16:28 And Samson called unto the Yahweh, and said, O Sovereign Elohim, remember me, I pray thee, and strengthen me, I pray thee, only this once, O Elohim, that I may be at once avenged of the Philistines for my two eyes.

#### **13. In fear of an enemy and in trembling:**

1Sa 28:5 And when Saul saw the host of the Philistines, he was afraid, and his heart greatly trembled.

1Sa 28:6 And when Saul enquired of the Yahweh, the Yahweh answered him not, neither by dreams, nor by Urim, nor by prophets.

#### **14. At the time of acknowledging the offence and in affliction:**

Hos 5:15 I will go and return to my place, till they acknowledge their offence, and seek my face: in their affliction they will seek me early.

#### **15. In vexation and in trouble:**

Neh 9:27 Therefore thou deliveredst them into the hand of their enemies, who vexed them: and in the time of their trouble, when they cried unto thee, thou heardest them from heaven; and according to thy manifold mercies thou gavest them saviours, who saved them out of the hand of their enemies.

By seeing all these references what we are learning is, people are only seeking Yahweh at the time of their troubles, afflictions, and so on: but we should not be timeservers, opportunitists, infidious, and any other unfaithful.

There are saints who never boather about troubles and searched and served Yahweh with thier pure heart.

For instance:

#### **1. Job:**

Job 2:10 But he said unto her, Thou speakest as one of the foolish women speaketh. What? shall we receive good at the hand of Elohim, and shall we not receive evil? In all this did not Job sin with

his lips.

Even in trouble, Job praised Yahweh: where as Job's wife is not.  
( Man is rational where as woman is intutional)

## **2. Habakkuk:**

Hab 3:17 Although the fig tree shall not blossom, neither shall fruit be in the vines; the labour of the olive shall fail, and the fields shall yield no meat; the flock shall be cut off from the fold, and there shall be no herd in the stalls:

Hab 3:18 Yet I will rejoice in the Yahweh, I will joy in the Elohim of my salvation.

Hab 3:19 The Yahweh Elohim is my strength, and he will make my feet like hinds' feet, and he will make me to walk upon mine high places. To the chief singer on my stringed instruments.

## **3. Micah:**

Mic 7:7 Therefore I will look unto the Yahweh; I will wait for the Elohim of my salvation: my Elohim will hear me.

Mic 7:8 Rejoice not against me, O mine enemy: when I fall, I shall arise; when I sit in darkness, the Yahweh shall be a light unto me.

Mic 7:9 I will bear the indignation of the Yahweh, because I have sinned against him, until he plead my cause, and execute judgment for me: he will bring me forth to the light, and I shall behold his righteousness.

Mic 7:10 Then she that is mine enemy shall see it, and shame shall cover her which said unto me, Where is the Yahweh thy Elohim? mine eyes shall behold her: now shall she be trodden down as the mire of the streets.

## **4. Solomon:**

Pro 30:8 Remove far from me vanity and lies: give me neither poverty nor riches; feed me with food convenient for me:

Pro 30:9 Lest I be full, and deny thee, and say, Who is the Yahweh? or lest I be poor, and steal, and take the name of my Elohim in vain.

## **5. Paul:**

Rom 8:35 Who shall separate us from the love of Messiah? shall tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or peril, or sword?

Rom 8:36 As it is written, For thy sake we are killed all the day long; we are accounted as sheep for the slaughter.

Rom 8:37 Nay, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him that loved us.

Rom 8:38 For I am persuaded, that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor powers, nor things present, nor things to come,

Rom 8:39 Nor height, nor depth, nor any other creature, shall be able to separate us from the love of Elohim, which is in Messiah Yahshua our Sovereign.

The above five references shows that nothing can separate us from the will of our Heavenly Father, if we are truthful followers. Many servants of Yahweh served Him even in trails and temptations,

they never give any place to devil in spite of all their troubles. Infact they challenged the trails.

In my field experience I have seen so many people who have abundant and everything for their lives, they never give any priority to Yahweh in all thier abundance. It is because of the pride that they have in thier hearts. They have everything just like "Sister Sodom". but Yahweh will take way all her abundance.

### **Iniquity of thy sister Sodom**

Eze 16:49 Behold, this was the iniquity of thy sister Sodom, pride, fulness of bread, and abundance of idleness was in her and in her daughters, neither did she strengthen the hand of the poor and needy.

Deu 28:47 Because thou servedst not the Yahweh thy Elohim with joyfulness, and with gladness of heart, for the abundance of all things;

Deu 28:48 Therefore shalt thou serve thine enemies which the Yahweh shall send against thee, in hunger, and in thirst, and in nakedness, and in want of all things: and he shall put a yoke of iron upon thy neck, until he have destroyed thee.

### **Becareful Yahweh's indignation for the daughter of Chaldeans:**

Isa 47:5 Sit thou silent, and get thee into darkness, O daughter of the Chaldeans: for thou shalt no more be called, The lady of kingdoms.

Isa 47:6 I was wroth with my people, I have polluted mine inheritance, and given them into thine hand: thou didst shew them no mercy; upon the ancient hast thou very heavily laid thy yoke.

Isa 47:7 And thou saidst, I shall be a lady for ever: so that thou didst not lay these things to thy heart, neither didst remember the latter end of it.

Isa 47:8 Therefore hear now this, thou that art given to pleasures, that dwellest carelessly, that sayest in thine heart, I am, and none else beside me; I shall not sit as a widow, neither shall I know the loss of children:

Isa 47:9 But these two things shall come to thee in a moment in one day, the loss of children, and widowhood: they shall come upon thee in their perfection for the multitude of thy sorceries, and for the great abundance of thine enchantments.

Isa 47:10 For thou hast trusted in thy wickedness: thou hast said, None seeth me. Thy wisdom and thy knowledge, it hath perverted thee; and thou hast said in thine heart, I am, and none else beside me.

Isa 47:11 Therefore shall evil come upon thee; thou shalt not know from whence it riseth: and mischief shall fall upon thee; thou shalt not be able to put it off: and desolation shall come upon thee suddenly, which thou shalt not know.

Isa 47:12 Stand now with thine enchantments, and with the multitude of thy sorceries, wherein thou hast laboured from thy youth; if so be thou shalt be able to profit, if so be thou mayest prevail.

Isa 47:13 Thou art wearied in the multitude of thy counsels. Let now the astrologers, the stargazers, the monthly prognosticators, stand up, and save thee from these things that shall come upon thee.

Isa 47:14 Behold, they shall be as stubble; the fire shall burn them; they shall not deliver themselves from the power of the flame: there shall not be a coal to warm at, nor fire to sit before it.

Isa 47:15 Thus shall they be unto thee with whom thou hast laboured, even thy merchants, from thy youth: they shall wander every one to his quarter; none shall save thee.

So, this is the WARNING for those who have abundance in everything. If we simply obey Him for our temporary benefits, or if we simply timeserve Him, He will not accept us. Yahweh hates timeservers, opportunitists, hirelings, want of material benefitters, etc.

Joh 6:26 Yahshua answered them and said, Verily, verily, I say unto you, Ye seek me, not because ye saw the miracles, but because ye did eat of the loaves, and were filled.

Joh 6:27 Labour not for the meat which perisheth, but for that meat which endureth unto everlasting life, which the Son of man shall give unto you: for him hath Elohim the Father sealed.

Act 3:5 And he gave heed unto them, expecting to receive something of them.

Act 3:6 Then Peter said, Silver and gold have I none; but such as I have give I thee: In the name of Yahshua Messiah of Nazareth rise up and walk.

Act 24:26 He hoped also that money should have been given him of Paul, that he might loose him: wherefore he sent for him the oftener, and communed with him.

### **We are warned to seek the Kingdom of Elohim first, not the material benefits:**

Mat 6:33 But seek ye first the kingdom of Elohim, and his righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you.

### **See the witness of Yahweh about Caleb:**

Num 14:24 But my servant Caleb, because he had another spirit with him, and hath followed me fully, him will I bring into the land whereinto he went; and his seed shall possess it.

Notice in the above sentence " he had an another spirit with him " If we have the same Spirit of Caleb, we can also serve Him like Caleb:

May the Heavenly Father give us such a Spirit to serve Him all through our life.
